ACTIVITY SCHEDULE - OVERALL NOTES It is encouraged for Scouts to leave an hour during the day of open time to enjoy the numerous open programs offered. The majority of open programs occur from Open 4:00pm - 5:00pm and in the evenings. Open programming does not require prior sign-up. A Scout can simply show-up at a program area when they would like to Programs: participate in an open program. Expanded open program opportunities in the evenings are also offered in addition to afternoons. Some programs have required age minimums and some programs have recommended age minimums. The purpose of age restrictions varies from program to program. Age When listed as "Recommended Age 13+", if the Scout is under the recommended age, it is suggested that the Scout have a conversation with their Scoutmaster or Restrictions Summer Camp Coordinator prior to signing-up for that merit badge. All programs meet Monday through Friday unless indicated otherwise next to the Merit Badge/Activity name. For example, Rowing meets on Monday, Tuesday, and Partial Week Wednesday. There are numerous opportunities in the program schedule to match-up two partial week activities so that a Scout has a full week of activities during a **Programs**: particular hour. Bolded numbers in the Notes and Prerequisites column correspond to the official BSA Merit Badge Requirements and are specific to each individual Merit Badge. The Prerequisites: requirements associated with each Merit Badge can be found at www.scouting.org/skills/merit-badges/all/ Camp is all-inclusive; there are no program/supply fees. This saves each Scout between \$30-\$60. Merit badge kits will be available in the program area where the Program merit badge is offered. For example, basketry kits will be available in Handicraft. Additional kits (beyond those provided) will be available in the Trading Post for Fees: purchase.
